How to get there:

Iceland's international airport is located in Keflavik, a town about 40 minutes drive from Reykjavík. Flybus runs with frequent departures from Keflavik to Reykjavik, <https://www.re.is/tour/flybus/>

- By a car to Akureyri is about 4,5 hours, 390 km.
- Direct flight from Reykjavík Domestic airport (**in Reykjavík**) to Akureyri 5 times per day (35 minutes flight), www.icelandair.com .
