ExCom Meeting 2023-2, 88th Council Meeting and AGA 2023 in Oslo, Norway

During the AGA week in Oslo, Norway, the ExCom, Council and AGA delegates met on 23, 24 and 25 May 2023, respectively. As a little fun fact: the AGA 2023 actually took place on the Association's 138th anniversary!

Besides the usual topics related to PIANC's finances, new Terms of Reference for publications and PIANC's upcoming international activities, the delegates also discussed the new Strategic Plan for 2024-2028, as well as an update on the PIANC Statutes.

Moreover, all delegates approved the following new mandates:

- Mr Calvin Creech, as the new PIANC Vice-President for the Americas, succeeding Mr Nick Pansic
- Mr Burton Suedel, as the new Chairman of PIANC EnviCom, succeeding Mr Todd Bridges

The following persons were appointed for another 4-year mandate:

- Mr Francisco Esteban Lefler as President of PIANC
- Mrs Anna-Lena Pahl as Chairperson of ProCom

Resolution 2023 – Oslo, Norway

Port development in general and the port's adaptation to the green shift for a low-emission society

The 135th Annual General Assembly of PIANC has been held in Oslo, the capital of Norway. The Port of Oslo is an important player in the cityscape with its wide range of activities and its presence at central locations in the city.

The Port of Oslo was established in 1735 by a royal decree. The Port of Oslo has played an important role in both national and especially international trade. Since then, development around the port has changed along with social and urban development. The Port of Oslo has had to evolve, just like most ports around the globe have.

The European Union has set itself high goals for a low-emission society, which gives guidance to the member states on how, among other things, maritime industry, ports and transport must develop to achieve the goals. This will require a new way of thinking in everything we do, thinking "smart and green", and share knowledge!

Especially in the last 10 years, the Norwegian authorities have invested large sums in ensuring that Norwegian ports, ships and maritime transport along the coast will meet the green shift and international requirements. By adopting modern technology as well as developing new application areas we believe we are on our way to achieve a zero-emission society.

PIANC recognizes the importance of having a strong focus on the green shift and the low-emission society. Through its work, especially in the Working groups, PIANC will be clear that sustainability must be a green thread in all work on the development of waterborne navigation infrastructure. The national sections will be an important factor in the success of this strategy.

As usual, during its meeting, FinCom went through the budget, statistics and figures of the Association and they had a fruitufl meeting.








Webinar for Seismic Design of Maritime Works. Presentation of the Design Basis. December 2022.

News from PIANC UK Ports and Offshore Wind Focus Seminar – 16 June 2023

- Chris Bell will discuss recent research on the scale of fuel production and supply infrastructure required to supply first mover green shipping corridors and the implications for ports.
- Malou Wagner will discuss the requirements for port infrastructure to support fixed & floating offshore wind projects in the construction phase, with an emphasis on foundation installation.
- Martin Mannion will discuss the requirements for port infrastructure to support fixed & floating offshore wind projects, with an emphasis on floating offshore wind.

Jamie Holmes will outline some of the key potential shipping and navigation risk and impacts between Floating offshore wind (FLOW) and fixed foundation projects, with reference to experiences on some of the world's first FLOW projects and will also look ahead at some of the key challenges that lie ahead as FLOW projects make the jump in scale from demonstration (typically <100MW) to commercial scale.
