PIANC MEDITERRANEAN DAYS 2023

The PIANC Mediterranean Days 2023 were held in partnership with 'Ports of the Future' by Cerema, from 25 to 27 October, in the recent magnificent 'conservatory' of music of Sète, France. It proved to be a great success with 350 attendees, of which 300 on-site and 50 online. Around 50 attendees came from various countries, mainly Spain, Italy, Portugal, as well as Morocco, the Netherlands and Algeria. Both sides of the Mediterranean Sea were represented, both from the attendees' side as in the presentations.

The 3-day conference was opened by the French Ministry of Transport and the President of Port de Sète Frontignan.

Thanks to the joint event, we had 87 presentations with complementary forms: 7 round tables, allowing the expression of general presentations and 9 technical sessions, allowing more detailed and technical presentations.

Among the presentations, the main ports topics were presented: economy and development, environmental and numerical transitions, technical projects, as well as adaptation to climate change. Please click <u>here</u> for the full programme.
